Connecticut T2 Center Equipment Loan Program – ADA Compliance Tools

How can you ensure your community is ADA compliant and friendly? How can you gauge if your pedestrian amenities allow for mobility or vision impaired users? By using the T2 Center’s ADA compliance toolkit, you can determine first-hand whether your community is accessible.

The kit includes the following items:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goggles to simulate several different visual impairments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Stroke, tumor or other injury can cause damage to one side of the brain, resulting in the loss of vision in the opposite side of both eyes (4 pairs) ✚ Blind spots in the middle of one’s vision, caused by various diseases, often age-related macular degeneration. (4 pairs) ✚ Tunnel Vision, often caused by glaucoma or retinitis pigmentosa. (4 pairs) ✚ Impaired visual acuity across the entire field of vision caused by cataracts (4 pairs) ✚ Low vision complications as a result of diabetic retinopathy (1 pair)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks to simulate total loss of vision (6 masks)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support canes, used in conjunction with goggles or masks (6 canes)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wheelchairs (2)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tape measure/digital level
