Local Traffic Authority 101

A CT Local Traffic Authority Program REQUIRED Workshop

On June 26, 2023, Governor Ned Lamont signed Senate Bill 904. Section 5 of the bill requires Local Traffic Authorities, or their designee, to attend a training program, through



the University of Connecticut's T2 Center, to provide them with critical knowledge and skills to better serve in this important role. This workshop will satisfy the annual requirement for training.

Who Should Attend

Municipal personnel who serve in the capacity of local traffic authority and/or their designee are encouraged to attend.

Course Instructors

Experts representing several units within CTDOT, UConn's Safety Circuit Rider Program and municipal attorneys will provide information on the responsibilities and implications of the LTA role and information on the resources and programs that are available to them to accomplish these tasks.
