

Sign Installation & Maintenance A CT Safety Academy Workshop

Roadway signs are the means by which a local agency communicates the rules, warnings, guidance, and other safety information that drivers need to navigate their roads and streets. This workshop will include examples of proper sign installation practices; roadway safety materials, including breakaway signposts, tamper, and vandal proof hardware; and inspection methods of retro-reflectivity properties. This class includes a field exercise that will allow you to put into practice what is learned during the classroom portion of the workshop.
