Competent Person for Trenching and Shoring

Trenching and Shoring activities are some of the most dangerous in public works. As such, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has very specific guidelines and requirements to ensure the safety of those involved.

This training is designed to satisfy the OSHA training requirements of a "competent person" to make inspections of excavations and the surrounding work areas to identify situations that could result in hazardous conditions (e.g., possible cave-ins, indications of failure of protective systems, hazardous atmospheres, or other hazardous conditions), and ensure that corrective measures are taken when necessary. Using lecture, group discussions, and field activities, participants will gain the knowledge they need to make these important decisions for your agency and your crews.
