Please note: All state and university COVID-19 precautions will be followed.

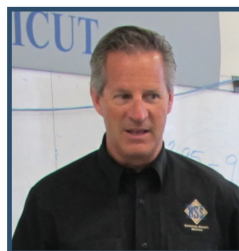
Who Should Attend
