*Please note: These are socially distant sessions. All state and university COVID-19 precautions will be followed.*

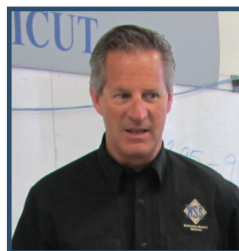
### Who Should Attend
