Underground Storage Tank Operator Training and Class A/B Certification and Re-Certification

A CT Road Master Program ELECTIVE Workshop

This course provides participants with the information they need to comply with the latest Connecticut Underground Storage Tank (UST) regulations, and will train and certify participants as Class A/B/C UST Operators.

It includes what you need to know to stay in compliance and gives direction on how to create your own inspection forms and conduct your own Class C training.

After morning training session, participants will take Class A/B/C Operator Exam.

Who Should Attend

This program is designed for those municipal highway officials responsible for the operation and maintenance of Underground Storage Tanks (UST).

Fleet Managers, Directors of Public Works, Highway Superintendents and Foremen are encouraged to attend.

Successful completion of the exam provides Class A/B/C Operator certification.

The exam is open book and consists of 60 questions for initial certification and 20 questions for renewal certification.

Participants have 90 minutes to complete the exam. 75 % of the questions must be answered correctly to pass and become certified.
